Nuisance Abatement Bylaw

No Feeding of Deer within Town Limits

- Name: Policy #2/2013 shall be cited the “No Feeding of Deer within Town Limits”
- Purpose: To stop individuals from feeding deer within the incorporated limits of the Town of Lanigan as it:
- Is not a recommended practise of Saskatchewan Environment
 - Deer within residential areas are creating a safety issue for individuals and properties
 - Properties are untidy and unsightly due to deer droppings and are considered a health issue
 - Deer running at large within the community draws coyotes which poses a safety issue to residents
- Objective: It is the objective of the Council of the Town of Lanigan that no person shall feed deer within the incorporated limits of the Town of Lanigan.
- Course of Action: Any person deemed to be feeding deer within the incorporated limits of the Town of Lanigan shall be
- 1). Notified in writing of this policy and shall cease the feeding of deer immediately
 - 2). Second Notice will be issued should an individual continue to violate this policy and a copy shall be sent to the RCMP.
 - 3). Should an individual continue to violate this policy after the Second Notice charges will be laid under Bylaw 12/2005 The Nuisance Abatement Bylaw. Further that Bylaw 1/85 the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Lanigan shall apply only to an infraction of a Bylaw of the Municipality for which no other fine is provided.
